

2013 CIOFF® World Folkloriada Anseong



In 2012, October 1 to 14, 44 nations (including Korea) from all over the world gathered in Anseong, South Korea to take part in the fourth CIOFF World Folkloriada. The Folkloriada aim at having spectators and visitors live the folklore experience through interactive activities instead of just watching a show. Many interactive activities were scheduled, including traditional games, traditional food experience from many countries, dances, listening to and learning to play an instrument and learning many traditional arts where participants and spectators will be able to experiment the heritage of the various cultures represented in Anseong Matchum Land.
